Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

On August 1, 1957, 7" Casing was set at 4872' and cemented in two stages, 1st stage with DV collar at 4315', cement with 100 sacks neat, second stage after 6 hours, cement with 50 sacks neat, 1000 sacks diaseal cement containing 1/8" flakes per sack followed by 75 sacks neat. After WOC 36 hours tested casing with 2100 psi for 30 minutes, no drop in pressure. Tested with 1000 psi for 30 minutes after drilling plug, no drop in pressure. Resumed operations.
