Ran 2-7/8" tubing and set Guiberson Unipacker VI with on-off tool at 13,346'. Perforated 5-1/2" liner from 13,434'-13,438'; 13,446'-13,454'; and 13,460'-13,468' with two shots per foot on 1-25-73. Treated perfs with 2000 gallons MS acid and 15 tons CO₂. Flowed well to clean up and flow tested well.

Set standing valve in profile in on-off tool. Unlatched tubing from on-off tool and ran second Guiberson Unipacker VI with on-off tool and set packer at 13,048'. Perforated 5-1/2" liner from 13,114'-13,126'; 13,154'-13,158'; 13,230'-13,238'; and 13,303'-13,314' with two shots per foot. Treated perfs with 3000 gallons 7.5% MS acid on 2-1-73. Flowed well to clean up and ran multi-point back pressure test on 2-3-73.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations; and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
