On October 3, 1973, a hearing was held by the Oil Conservation Commission to consider the application of Belco Petroleum Corporation to form a non-standard gas proration unit and drill a well on this unit at an unorthodox location of 660' FSL & 1300' FEL, Section 3), T-20-S, R-33-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Due to our not having received the action of the Oil Conservation Commission on this matter at this time, Belco Petroleun Corporation is submitting the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Forn C-102 without the acreage dedicated to the subject well outlined as would be normal.
