8. LOCATION OF CAMPS

This point is not applicable since no camp or other permanent structures will be installed in the vicinity and due to the drilling and operation of this proposed well.

9. <u>LOCATION OF AIRSTRIPS</u>

No airstrip will be constructed for this proposed well.

10. LOCATION LAYOUT TO INCLUDE POSITION OF THE RIG, MUD TANKS, RESERVE PITS, BURN PITS, PIPE RACKS, ETC.

Attachment 3 is a plat drawn to a scale of one (1) inch equals twenty-five (25) feet to indicate the layout of the small portable drilling rig and related equipment to be used in drilling this proposed well.

11. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SURFACE

No surface restoration will be necessary since the proposed well will be drilled on the existing pad and no new road or location pad will be built.

12. IMPACT ON ENVIRONMENT

The surface in the vicinity of the proposed well consists of sandy soil with some caliche outcrops in places. The vegetation consists of sparce range grasses interspersed with mesquite bushes. No disturbance of the environment will occur through the drilling and producing operations of this proposed well except for travel on existing lease roads.
