

site, i.e., not closer than 300 ft north or south of it. During road improvements, and these will probably be of a minimal nature in the immediate vicinity of the site because of the generally sound condition of the existing road bed there, grading equipment and trucks should be confined strictly to the existing right-of-way. Lastly, NMAS suggests that Ring Midden No. 5, the feature situated due east of the existing road bed be fenced, and further, that the road bed be shifted slightly to the west in order to ensure its continued integrity.
