MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLANS

GRACE PETROLEUM CORPORATION FELMONT FEDERAL #2 660' FSL and 760' FEL, Sec. 25, T-20-S, R-32-E LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a highway map showing the location of the proposed well as staked; one and one-half miles southeast of Halfway, New Mexico and 35 miles northwest of Eunice, New Mexico on State Highway 176. From the intersection of State Highway 180 and State Highway 176 (near Halfway, New Mexico), go .8 mile east on State Highway 176. Turn right on caliche road for 1 mile south, turn left to location. No additional road will be necessary.
- B. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing all existing roads within a one mile radius of the wellsite, and the planned access road.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. Length and Width: No additional roads required.
- B. <u>Surfacing Material</u>: Will use existing caliche pad.
- C. <u>Maximum Grade</u>: Existing road.
- D. Turnouts: No new turnouts will be needed.
- E. <u>Drainage Design</u>: Existing road has adequate drainage.
- F. <u>Culverts</u>: None required.
- G. <u>Cuts and fills</u>: None required.
- H. <u>Gates, Cattleguards</u>: No additional gates or cattleguard will be required.

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
