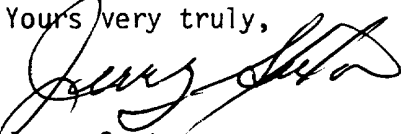

Gentlemen:

We are currently in the process of filing a C-101 and C-102 with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's district office in Hobbs for permission to recomplete an existing oil well to an Eumont (Gas) well. The well will be in the same zone as another Eumont gas well on an existing 160-acre proration unit comprised of the SE/4 Sec. 8, T19S, R37E, Unit O. The subject proration unit is currently dedicated to our Huston #1 located in Sec. 8, T19S, R37E, Unit O. I hereby file for administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the 160-acre proration unit, consisting of the SE/4 of Section 8 to both our existing well (Huston #1) located in Sec. 8, R19S, R37E, Unit O and our proposed recompleted well (Huston #2) located in Sec. 7, T22S, R37E, Unit J. The Huston No. 2 is currently a producing Eunice Monument oil well.

Three copies of a plat showing the location of the original well on the existing 160-acre proration unit plus the location of the proposed well are enclosed.

Copies of this plat and application have also been sent to all offsetting parties owning shallow Eumont dry gas rights. The following is a list of the offset Eumont owners:

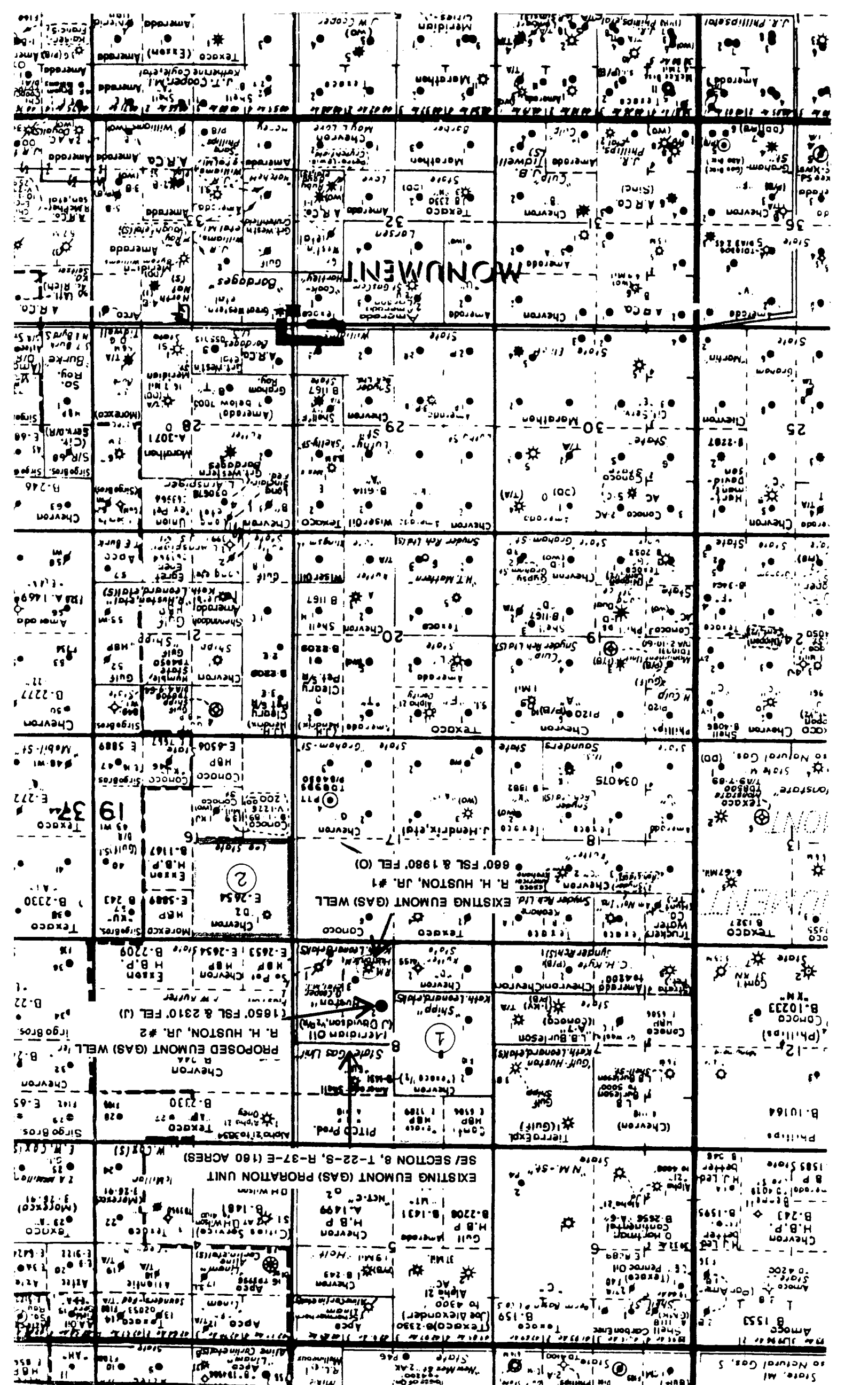
