Cultural Resources

No archaeological sites or isolated manifestations were recorded during this reconnaissance. The overall absence of material cultural resources is due to a lack of lithic material suited to the needs of the stone tool making artisan, a shortage of potable water since Pleistocene times, the openness of the associated landform, and distance to localities where the aforementioned are available. In post-Pleistocene times, Monument Springs and its environs have been the preferred areas for human occupancy.

Recommendations

NHAS recommends clearance for Great Western Drilling Company's proposed Bordages Well No. 3 and its access road and suggests that work-related activities proceed in accordance with company plans.
