(4) That the applicant's proposed salt water disposal program will not jeopardize the production of oil, gas, or fresh water in the area and is consonant with sound conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant be and the same is hereby authorized to dispose of produced salt water into the San Andres formation through the Hobbs SWD Well No. F-29 to be located 1880 feet from the North line and 1741 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 16 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Hobbs Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, with the injection interval being between 4450 feet and 5050 feet.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That disposal shall be through inner casing and that the casing-casing annulus shall be kept full of naphtha or kerosene.

(2) That the applicant shall submit monthly reports of its disposal operations in accordance with Rules 704 and 1119 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
