

Proposed Development Plan for Surface Use
Federal BT Gas Com. No. 1
1980' FSL & 1980' FEL, Sec. 15
T-20-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico

1. Existing roads including location of exit from main highway.

Detailed map showing drillsite location in relation to the nearest town and all existing roads within one mile of the wellsite are shown on Exhibit A.

2. Planned access roads.

From Eunice go 15.4 miles west on State Highway 179. Turn right and go 7.9 mile north and west on County Road 35. After crossing third cattle guard, road veers northeast for .5 mile. Road veers west again and access turnoff is .5 mile.

Approximately 2000' access road will be built.

3. Location of existing wells.

All existing well within one mile radius are shown on Exhibit C.

4. Location of tank batteries and flow lines

If the well is commercially productive, the production facilities (i.e. tanks, separators, & treaters) will be located on pad.

5. Location and type of water supply.

Fresh & brine water to be hauled by commercial hauler.

6. Source of construction materials.

Caliche will be obtained from pit on privately owned land.

7. WASTE DISPOSAL

- a. Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the reserve pit.
- b. Drilling fluids will be allowed to evaporate in the reserve pit until the pit is dry.
