All self-certified corrections must be postmarked no later than the next

Section 109(d)(1) of the Federal Oil and Gas Royalty Management Act of 1982, as implemented by the applicable provisions of the operating regulations at Title 43 CFR 3163.2(f)(1), provides that any person who "knowingly or willfully" prepares, maintains, or submits false, inaccurate, or misleading reports, notices, affidavits, records, data, or other written information required by this part shall be liable for a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per violation for each day such violation continues, not to exceed a maximum of 20 days.

The purpose of this letter is to request approval of the off-lease measurement of gas from the above lease. The lease contains one well.

The gas from this lease is measured initially by the company's meter on lease. It is then transported through a polyethylene line approximately 1 1/2 miles north to the Anadarado - Teas Yates Unit in section 14 where it is measured for sale by Phillips 66, the gas purchaser of the South Teas federal lease. There are no off-lease storage facilities and no gas is lost between meters.

The decision for off-lease measurement was made based on economics. It cost Woodbine far less to run a low pressure line to Phillips' existing line, than the purchase would have charged for running their line to the lease.


