The above-referenced well was completed as a Laguna Valley-Morro₩ gas well with the unorthodox location approved by NSL-2256. This well was also completed in the Bone Spring zone and comes under the Lea-Bone Spring Pool which has special spacing rules (80-acres with well located within 150 feet of center of any qtr/qtr sec.)

I believe Evelyn Downs of this office advised you of the need for approval of the unorthodox Bone Spring location by phone in July and you indicated an application for approval of the unorthodox Bone Spring completion would be forthcoming. As of this date we have not received a copy of this application in our office and Santa Fe indicates they have not received a request for such approval.

Your allowable for the Lea-Bone Spring completion cannot be approved until you have obtained approval of the unorthodox location. Your prompt attention to this matter is required.
