- 10-5-88 Perforate at 3525', 3535', 3539', 3547', 3552', 3584', 3589', 3591', 3593', 3594', 3596', 3600' & 3605' (13 holes). Set Baker Mod. "R" DG Packer at 3404'. Acidize with 1500 gals 15% NEFE acid with clay stabilizer and 22 ball sealers. Swab dry after acid job.
- 10-7-88 Fracture treat with 15,000 gals gel water with 29,000# 12/20 sand. Screened out after 26,500# of sand was in formation.
- 10-8-88 Rig up to swab. Swab down in three runs. Make 5 more runs. Mostly oil on 7th and 8th runs. Release Packer and go in hole. Tag sand at 3486'. Pull Packer. Go in hole with notched collar. Clean out sand to 3654'. Pull out of hole. Re-run Packer. Set at 3469'.
- 10-9-88 Swab test. Swabbing at rate of 40 - 50 bbls fluid per day with 50% oil. Rig down pulling unit. Waiting on pumping unit and tank battery.

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
