Gentlemen:

As per your conversation with this office on February 26, 1990, concerning your over-production of casinghead gas from the above-referneced well. It is our understanding that the well was shutin due to production problems resulting from Phillips line problems from September 15, 1989, thru November 20, 1989. After Chevron was connected to the well November 20, 1989, it was returned to production and during the months of December 1989, and January 1990, the well produced at a rate in excess of the monthly casinghead gas allowable.

Based upon the fact that the well was curtailed due to pipeline problems during a portion of September and all of October the well will not be considered to be over-produced on casinghead gas.

However, you will be expected to strictly adhere to our casinghead gas limit for this well as no further exceptions will be granted.
