Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests your approval of our administrative application for the subject Unorthodox Gas Well Location and Simultaneous Dedication.

We are currently planning to drill the R. R. Bell (NCT-F) Well No. 3, and complete this well in the Eumont Yates 7 Rvrs Qn (Pro Gas) Pool. This well will be located 1520 feet FNL and 1820 feet FWL of Section 36, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This location will be within an existing 320-acre Eumont Gas Proration Unit currently dedicated to Chevron's existing R. R. Bell (NCT-F) Well No. 2 (NSP Order-185). We plan to Simultaneously Dedicate this 320-acres to both of these wells. The location was chosen to avoid pipelines in the area and will be unorthodox in that it is less than 330 feet from the quarter-quarter section line. Also, per conversation with Mr. Michael Stogner on September 25, 1990, we were advised to proceed with this application administratively.

In order to prevent waste, Chevron respectfully requests your approval of this administrative application under the
