Gentlemen:

Texaco E & P Inc. respectfully requests your approval of this administrative application for the subject Unorthodox Oil Well Location.

Texaco drilled its **L. Van Etten No. 13** with the intention of completing in the Weir Blinebry, Monument Tubb, or Wildcat Pennsylvanian. It was drilled at a standard location for these three target zones. After the well was completed, the NMOCD in Hobbs informed Texaco that the well will be in the Cass Penn Pool. As a result, it is at an unorthodox oil well location because it is located more than 150' from the center of either quarter/quarter section dedicated to the well. The location of Well No. 13 is 1653' FSL, 2307' FWL, Unit Letter K, Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
