Me-Tex Oil & Gas, Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the R.R. Bell "H" #3 well to be located 990' from North line, 330' from East line, Section 23, T-19S, R-36E in Lea County, New Mexico. This location is unorthodox due to being closer than 660 feet to the nearest quarter-quarter section line. This well is assigned to a previously approved 200 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool, Order No. R-655. Me-Tex requests simultaneous dedication of the Eumont gas production from the R.R. Bell "H" #1 with the Eumont gas production from the R.R. Bell "H" #3 well.
