Chevron U.S.A., Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for the following amendments to CTB-452.

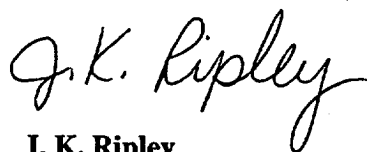
The wells included in this permit are producing from Monument;Abo (not North Monument Abo as stated in captioned permit).

Monument "23" State #19 has different working interest owners than the other 3 wells covered by the permit. The production from this well will soon be going through a dedicated metering separator. The separator is now being assembled.
