Cemented 7 " O.D. casing at a total depth of 3664' with
500 sacks of cement. Allowed cement to set 72 hours, after
which plug was drilled. Bailed hole dry, tested with
Haliburton with 1400 lb pressure. Hole was dry.
Drilling was resumed.
