Dear Mr. Burleson:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application (*application reference No. pKRV0-223831905*) dated August 19, 2002; and (ii) the records of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe, including the files for Division Order No. R-671, issued in Case No. 917 on July 27, 1955, and Division Administrative Order NSP-1729, dated July 11, 1995: all concerning Lewis B. Burleson, Inc.'s request for a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool (76480):

> LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO <u>TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM</u> Section 17: SE/4.

This unit is to be dedicated to your proposed State "V" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-35997) to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1650 feet from the South line and 1880 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 17.

The subject application has been duly filed under the provisions of the "Special Pool Rules for the Eumont Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170-P, issued in Case No. 12563 on December 14, 2001.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 4 (C) and (D) of the special rules now governing the Eumont Gas Pool, the above-described non-standard 160-acre gas spacing unit is hereby approved.

Jurisdiction of this matter shall be further retained for the entry of any such subsequent orders, as the Division may deem necessary.
