Dear Mr. Blevins:

The latest gas-oil ratio test for your C. H. Weir "B" No. 3 in Unit A of Section 11, T-20-S, R-37-E indicates that the well has a ratio of 157,333:1.

In compliance with the provisions of Commission Order R-520, you are hereby advised that the oil allowable for the well will be cancelled effective August 1, 1958. This should give you sufficient time to apply for a Non-Standard Proration Unit and file Form C-128 showing the acreage to be dedicated, in order that a gas allowable may be assigned.
