RE: Administrative application for the formation of a non-standard 280-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the W/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4, and SE/4 of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, for the C. H. Wier "B" Well No. 5 (API No. 30-025-06062), located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 11.

So that I might process the subject application more effectively and effectively, please provide me a land plat showing the subject 280-acre tract and <u>all</u> off-setting Eumont gas spacing and proration units with the individual units shaded for easier identification, all Eumont wells completed therein, and references to all previous orders that established any such non-standard GPU. Further, is the subject 280-acre tract or any part of it currently included within an existing Eumont gas unit or has this 280-acre tract or any part of it ever been included within a previous Eumont gas unit (please reference any and all applicable Division orders).

Also, provide a brief explanation as to why the 40 acres comprising the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of said Section 11 is being excluded from this dedication.
