Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of March 15, 1962, wherein you advise that your C. H. Weir "B" Well No. 5 has been completed as an oil-oil-oil triple in the Skaggs-Drinkard, Skaggs-Glorieta and Undesignated Blinbry oil pools.

This completion is in exception to the authorized completion of said well as an oil-oil-gas triple in the same formations, and your letter requests an amendment of Order No. R-2181 to provide for oil rather than gas to be produced from the Blinbry formation.

It will be necessary to bring this matter to hearing to so amend the order for two reasons. First, any order entered after hearing may be amended only after hearing and secondly, the production of oil through one-inch tubing may not be authorized in any event without a hearing.

Texaco Inc. is, however, hereby authorized to produce all zones of the subject triple completion in accordance with normal procedures until such time as an order in this case
