Dear Sir:

Please be referred to your letter of February 4, 1959, addressed to this office stating that our Skaggs B-12 No. 2 well, located D 12-20-37 in the Eumont Oil Pool, is to be reclassified as a gas well due to a gas-oil ratio of 225,625/1.


The packer in this well is set at a depth of 3729 feet with perforations as follows: 3690-3710', 3737-48', 3753-66', 3772-81' and 3798-3807'. A P.S.I. nipple is set at 3717'.

Recently a separation tool was installed at 3717' to allow production from below the packer only. A gas-oil ratio test was performed on February 22, 1959, and in 24 hours well produced 16 barrels of oil and 1,451 MCF of gas for a gas-oil ratio of 90,687/1.

In view of the work performed resulting in a gas-oil ratio decrease to below the legal limit of 100,000/1, we respectfully request that the reclassification of this well as a gas well be cancelled.
