Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval for reduction of the acreage assigned to the SEMU Permian No. 41 by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-1155 from 200 acres consisting of the S/2 S/2, NW/4 SW/4 Section 13, T-20S, R-37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to a non-standard gas proration unit to consist of 80 acres consisting of the S/2 SE/4 of said Section 13. We therefore request cancellation of Order No. R-1155 and the establishment of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the 80 acres described above to be allocated to the SEMU Permian No. 41 located 660 feet from the South and East lines of said Section 13.

In support of this request, we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Pool of Order No. R-520 in all respects as follows:

1. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
2. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
