DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a depth of approximately 3700' with rotary tools and from 3700' to a total depth of approximately 3910' with reverse circulation tools. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is proposed to use the following casing pattern: 10 3/4" casing to be set at approximately 350' with 250 sacks cement, cement to be circulated; 5 1/2" casing to be set at approximately 3700' with approximately 145 sacks cement or equivalent cement to cover the salt section. If necessary, the pay section will be shot.

Approval to produce the well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
