DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a total depth of approximately 3,910'. All casing will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 8 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 250' and cemented with approximately 250 sacks cement to be circulated to surface; 5 1/2" casing to be set at approximately 3,910' and cemented with approximately 1,150 sacks cement, exact amount to be determined by caliper survey. Casing to be perforated opposite the pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
