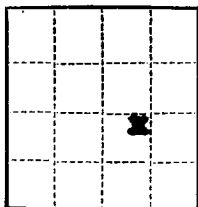

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to Granite, approximately 10,200', in order to test a large block of N. M. P. U. acreage as yet not evaluated below the Queen. The drilling will be done with rotary tools. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 13 3/8" to be set at 180' and cemented with approximately 300 sacks, cement to be circulated. 9 5/8" to be set at 4,000' and cemented with approximately 1600 sacks. 7" to be set at 10,200' and cemented with approximately 900 sacks, and to be perforated opposite the pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

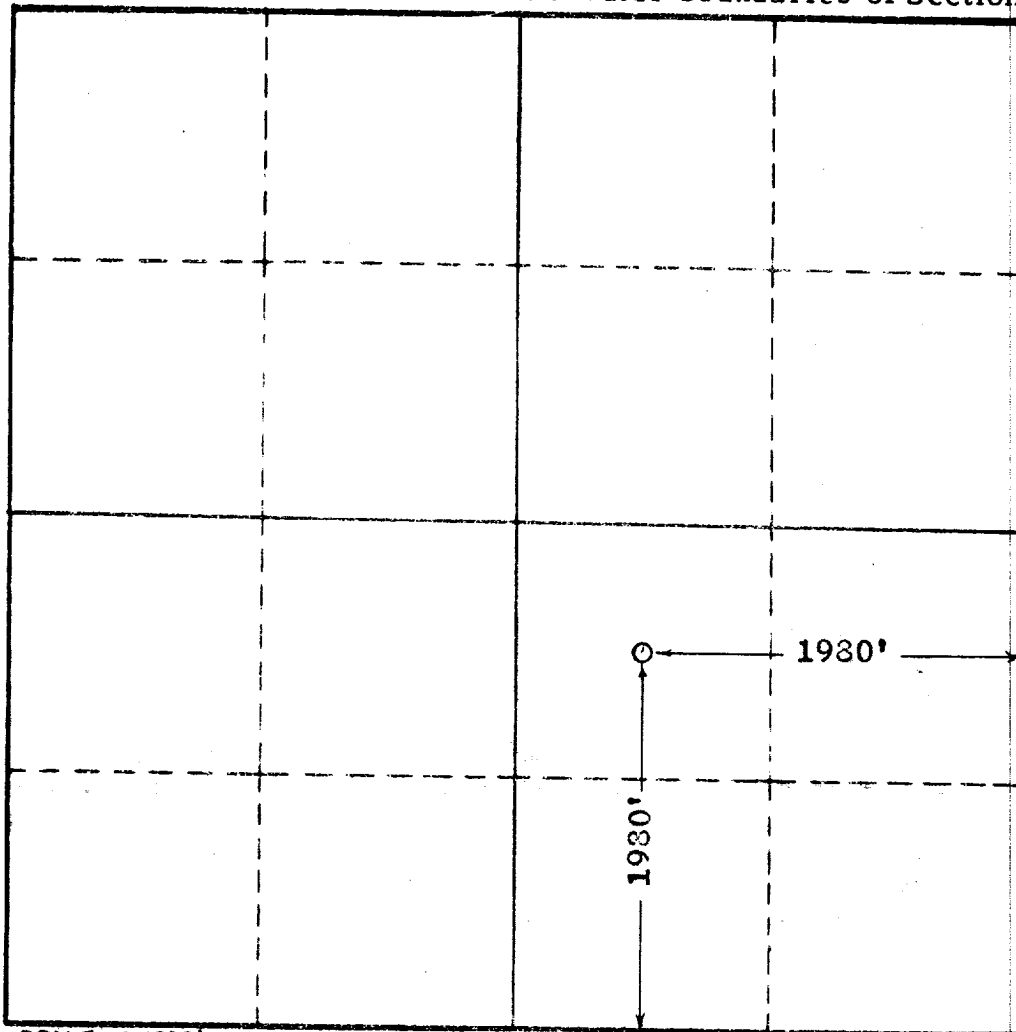
