DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a TD of approximately 6600' with rotary tools in order to develop Tubb and Minebry oil reserves in this lease. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the USGS and any special requirements will be followed.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 8 5/8" surface string to be set at 1200' and cemented with 335 sx cmt. Cement calculated to circulate. 5 1/2" production string to be set at 6600' and cemented with 385 sx cmt. Cement is calculated to return to 2300'.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
