trative Approval for an Oil-Oil  
Dual for the SEMU DT No. 70.

Gentlemen:

We respectfully request cancellation of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order Nos. DC-819 and R-1499, which approved the gas-oil dual completion and a non-standard gas preration unit for the Tubb formation in Continental Oil Company's SEMU DT No. 70 and request administrative approval of the oil-oil dual completion of the above well. We are attaching two copies of the Applisication for Dual Completion.

When the application for gas-oil dual completion was originally submitted, it was anticipated that the Tubb zone would be completed as a gas producer, however, on February 5, 1960, the well was tested in the Tubb formation and was

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completed as an oil well.

We therefore request cancellation of the above Orders and request administrative approval to dually complete the SEMU DT No. 70 as an oil-oil dual in the Drinkard and Tubb formations.
