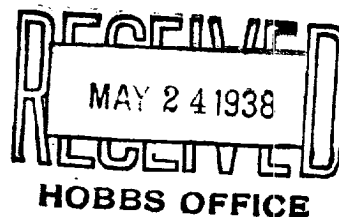

The first seven hours of which the well flowed 288 barrels thru open choke on 2" EUE tubing, before being pinched back on 16/64" choke.
