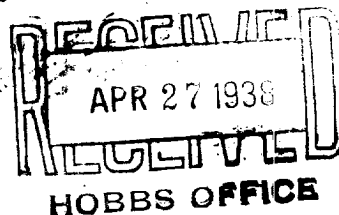

7 5/8" 26.60# seamless casing has been set and cemented at 2440' with 400 sacks of common cement. 4/24/38. This well will be allowed to stand undisturbed for 72 hours after which pump pressure of 1200# will be applied to the casing and fittings, the valves closed, and the well allowed to stand undisturbed for 30 minutes. If there is no drop in pump pressure, the cement plug will be drilled and the same test again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for 30 minutes. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will be resumed.
