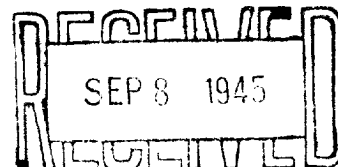

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled tubing and reamed hole to 3850'. Ran tubing back and ran Dowell Electric Survey and pulled tubing. Filled hole from 3850' to 3844' with sand, dumped 16 gals Dowell plastic and squeezed with 400# pressure, hole filled up to 3832'. Dumped 8 gals plastic and squeezed with 500# pressure hole filled up to 3827'. Ran 2" tubing and circulated well with oil. Swabbed well in and it flowed 73 bbls in 3 hours thru open 2" tubing with no water. Put on 21/64ths inch choke and well flowed 162.49 bbls in 24 hours with no water.
