DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 3835' Lime, Well was making 99% water. Pulled Tubing and Cleaned out to bottom with bit and dumped 265 Gallons of Plastic in 16 stages and 7 Gallons of pea Gravel and plugged back to 3796'. On April 14, 1946 Set 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " EUE Tubing at 3789' and swabbed well in and started to flowing and flowed 411 Barrels of Clean Pipe Line Oil on $\frac{1}{4}$ " Choke in 24 hours Casing Pressure 200 Tubing Pressure 300# Gas Volume 142,500 Gas Oil Ratio 347.
