DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 3865'. Set 5-1/2" Baker Model K cast iron bridging plug at 3775'. Pumped 1/2 sack cement on top, let stand 4 hours. Ran steel line measure and found top of cement at 3774'. Job complete at 4:00 PM 6th.

Tested casing and plug with 300# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Perforated 5-1/2" casing with 4 jet holes per foot from 3760' to 3740'. Job complete at 11:30 AM 7th.

RESULTS: Produced 95 barrels oil, 29500 barrels water in January, which was before workover.

Production on test after workover: Flowed 297 bbls 31.3 gravity oil, .8% BS&W thru 2-3/8" tubing WO in 10 hours.
