Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas provation unit comprising the NE/4 and E/2 of NW/4 Section 17, T2OS, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Theodore Anderson Lease, a portion of which is above described.
- (2) The Theodore Anderson #4, located 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line, Section 17, T2OS, R37E. Lea County, New Mexico, was completed March 11, 1937, in the Monument Oil Pool at a depth of 3870 feet; and an application to dually complete this well in the Eumont Gas Pool was approved on July 9, 1954, by Commission Order DC-136. The applicant proposes to use this well as the Unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas provide unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.

- (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
- (e) By copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation to form the proposed non-standard gas prevation unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas provision unit.
