## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 14, 1946, the hole was swabbed dry, and loaded above the packer with 96 bbl oil. Acidized with 1,000 gallons by Chemical Process, time of injection 30 minutes, duration of treatment 40 minutes.

Production before: Flow 30 bbl fluid cut 4% water in 24 hours; would not flow steady.

Production after: Flow 125 bbl oil and 29 bbl water in 24 hours, through 1/2" choke 1-1/2 rounds open. Gas 49,870 cu. ft.
