DETAILS OF WORK

The subject well has been shut in since August, 1949, after testing 100% water.

In an attempt to exclude water and place this well back on production, it is proposed to install liner as follows:

The hole will be run to total depth, 3877', and radioactivity and spinner surveys will be run. A 4" OD steel alloy liner will be set on bottom and squeeze cemented with approximately 50 sacks cement. The liner will be perforated and tested as indicated by the radioactivity and spinner surveys.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
