Took 24 hour test after swabbing out acid and oil load starting 7:00 A.M., Dec. 6, and ending 7:00 A.M. Dec. 7, 1936. Gauged 74 bbls. oil, 0 water, 24 hours. Gas estimated 450,000. Well flowing natural by heads.
