DETAILS OF WORK

TD 3870' - Lime. On June 20th treated pay formation from 3760 to 3870' with 4000 gallons Dowell "XX" solution through tubing. Treated by Dowell Inc. Production before none.

Production after - Recovered oil load in 1 hour, & 20 minutes. Made 214 barrels oil, no water, gas lift next 17 hours. Discontinued high pressure gas on morning of June 21st. Flowed 1 barrel oil in 15 minutes and died. Shut in 24 hours to pressure up. On June 22nd flowed 149 barrels oil, no water in 5 hours and died. Flowed natural through tubing. Gas measured 1,300,000 after first hour and 1,150,000 after 1 1/2 hours. Gas too low to measure last 3 hours. Plan to retreat.
