Gentlemen:

By Order No. DC-161, dated September 20, 1954, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission granted Phillips Petroleum Company approval to dually complete its Hobbs Well No. 4, between the Queen Formation of the Eumont Gas Pool and the Grayburg-San Andres Formation of the Eunice-Monument Oil Pool.

Our Hobbs lease, described as the SW/4 of Section 18, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, contains a total of 160 acres as shown on the attached plat.
