It is the purpose of this sundry notice to request continued TA status for this well. It is possible that this well may be recompleted in the Eumont-Yates-7 Rvrs Queen in the near future. The Mexico No. 3 is currently completed in the Eumont. This well may be used as a replacement well or an additional well in the Eumont. Plugging this well now may result in a premature abandonment resulting in lost Eumont reserves. A casing integrity test was conducted April 1, 1999. In addition John H. Hendrix Corporation has shown that it is a responsible operator where it is necessary to plug a well.
