It is the purpose of this sundry notice to request continued TA status for this well. It is possible that this well may be recompleat in the Eumont-Yates-7 Rvrs Queen in the near future. The Mexico No. 3 is currently completed in the Eumont and the 40 acres dedicated to the Patsy Lease is dedicated to a 160 acre Eumont gas producer. The Patsy No. 1 may be used as a replacement well or an additional well in the Eumont. Plugging this well now may result in a premature abandonment resulting in lost Eumont reserves. A casing integrity test was conducted April 8, 2002. In addition John H. Hendrix Corporation has shown that it is a responsible operator where it is necessary to plug a well. It is requested that the TA status be granted for 5 years.
