Gentlemen:

Phillips Petroleum Company hereby makes application for administrative approval to dual-complete its subject well in the Eunice Oil Pool and the Eumont Gas Pool. In support of this request we state the following facts:

1. This lease is described as the E/2 SE/4 Sec. 19, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico and consisting of 80 acres.
2. The well is known as Quapaw No. 1 and is located 660' from south and east lines, Sec. 19, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County.
3. A diagrammatic sketch is attached, showing (a) the formations involved, (b) perforations, and (c) location of the packer.
4. Phillips Petroleum Company and Gulf Oil Corporation have completed a communitization agreement, approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands, which provides for the dedication of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the SE/4 of Sec. 19. The approval of this application then will, in the opinion of the applicant, prevent waste, protect correlative rights and serve the best interest of conservation.
5. By copy of this letter of application all offset operators are notified by registered mail of the intent to dual complete this well.
