DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3840. Treated pay formations from 3744 to 3840 with 5000 gallons Dowell "X" and 5000 gallons Dowell "XX" solution.

First 24 hours swabbed & flowed 304 barrels oil & acid lead cutting 5% water & 27% BS. Gas tested 1,800,000. 175# casing pressure. Next day flowed 138 barrels fluid in 24 hours. 5% water, 15% BS. Gas measured 1,900,000. Following day flowed 24 hours natural through 2½" tubing. 99 barrels fluid cutting 1½% BS, no water. On the day following flowed 75 barrels oil in 15 hours through 2½" tubing. 1% BS, no water and shut in for tank room.
