Total depth 3840 in line. Treated pay formations from 3744 to 3840 with 8000 gallons Dowell "XX" solution. Started swabbing immediately recovering 140 barrels oil load and acid in 10 hours. Swabs down. No fresh oil or gas showing. Next day swabbed 24 hours. 94 barrels oil load and acid. No gas. Following day swabbed 22 hours. 78 barrels oil load and water from acid treatment. Prepared to deepen.
