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


DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3840 in lime. Loaded hole with oil & treated with 1000 gallons Dowell "XX".

Started swabbing 2 1/2 hours after treating. Swabbed 4 hours through tubing and well started flowing. Recovered all oil load & blew dry. Shut in over night. Opened next morning through tubing. Made 17 bbl. oil, 0 water, one head flow. Gas broke around bottom of tubing. Shut in next morning & opened same evening. Made 3 1/2 barrels oil, no water. Opened next morning. Flowed 4 bbl. oil, no water. Would not flow next day.
