Total Depth, 3866' - Lime. 5 1/2" casing cemented at 3670' with 125 sacks.

The present production rate on this well is very near the economic limit, and we desire permission to shoot the section from approximately 3835' to 3866' with approximately 80 quarts of nitro-glycerin, using a 1-yard gravel tamp, in an attempt to increase the oil production.

Results of this work will be reported after operations are completed.
