DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. - 3863' - Lime.

Work-over begun 6-12-41. Lowered tubing 63'. Acidized with 2500 gallons and swabbed 122 barrels fluid, 50% B.S. & W. 6-17-41, well flowed 11 barrels oil in 2 hours and died. 6-20-41 acidized with 6000 gallons, and on 6-22-41 swabbed 58 barrels in 22 hours from 20% to 4% B.S. & W. 7-11-41 ran 2" tubing with 2-2" Merla flow valves, one at 3033' and one at 3368'. 7-15-41 completed, flowed 168 bbls. P.L. oil in 24 hours, with G.O.R. 1150.
