Turned into tanks at 6:09 PM and 1st hour flowed 9.52 barrels; 2nd hour flowed 6.12 barrels; 3rd hour flowed 4.76 barrels; 4th hour flowed 4.08 barrels; 5th hour flowed 2.72 barrels; 6th hour flowed 4.77 barrels; 7th hour flowed 2.72 barrels; 8th hour flowed 2.72 barrels; 9th hour flowed 2.72 barrels. Total 9 hours 40.13 barrels, estimated 3,500,000 cu ft gas. 5% BS&W.

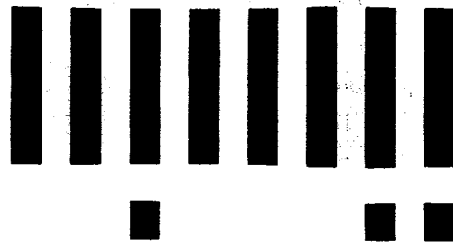

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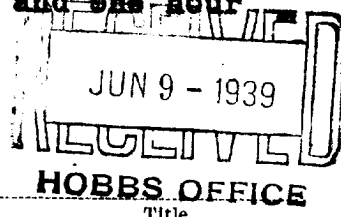
